The Course

The 5K will start at the entrance to Stump Lake Park on ND Hwy 1. It is approximately 1.5 miles from the start to the Historical Society’s Stump Lake Village. The 2K fun run/walk will start at Stump Lake Village. Both events will then loop around Stump Lake Park and end at the Village. Buses will be available to take all 5K entrants to the starting line.

The course is relatively flat with 2 small hills. Running surface is asphalt with a short (.3 mile) section of gravel.
